


Your Challenge




Children count and group objects into a teen number. Have children count a group of objects, making sure there is a teen number of objects. Then have them circle the group. Children repeat this process until all the objects have been grouped into groups of teen numbers. If children are left with a number of objects that is less than a teen, have them explain how they will adjust the groups so that they are all teen numbers.
