Check Understanding

Child shows number card and 10-frame card for 4.

Recording Sheet

Answers will vary. Sample answers:

9 is more than 5.

7 is more than 4.

Check Understanding

4 is less than 5. Check how students show this with counters.

Check Understanding

7 is more than 4. Explanations will vary.

Recording Sheet

For top of **Recording Sheet**, children color 1–3 blue, circle 4, and color 5–10 red.

For bottom of **Recording Sheet**, children color 1–5 blue, circle 6, and color 7–10 red.

★★★ Above Level

Check Understanding

Sample answer: The numbers that are less than 5 come before 5 when I count.

Recording Sheet

Check that children write and color numbers 1–4 blue, write and circle 5, and write and color numbers 6–10 red.
