


Check Understanding Show a cube train of 10 cubes and 4 separate cubes. Ask the child to write the number of cubes.



What You Need

- 10 counters
- crayons in two colors
- Recording Sheet for each child

What You Do

- 1. Partner A starts with 25 and counts slowly by ones.
- 2. On a **Recording Sheet**, Partner B puts counters on the numbers that Partner A says.
- 3. Partner B says the numbers with the counters in order along the pathway. Partner A checks the count.
- 4. Switch roles. Repeat the steps with Partner B starting with 67 and counting by ones.


